Vancouver, B.C. – During a routine barge-to-barge transfer at the Parkland Legacy Barge in Coal Harbour, a pinched hose and a rupture resulted in a substantial amount of diesel fuel entering the water. A Unified Command has been established to coordinate all aspects of the response. The Unified Command includes Parkland, the Canadian Coast Guard, City of Vancouver and BC Ministry of Environment. Western Canada Marine Response Corp. has been activated to lead the cleanup operation.
